Policy Language

If a student-athlete wishes to appeal a scholarship decision and remain enrolled at Liberty, he or she has the right to a hearing by a body outside of athletics in accordance with NCAA bylaw 15.3.2.4. Upon written notification of the intent to remove the scholarship, the student-athlete must request a hearing in writing to the Senior Supervisor of Financial Aid NCAA Compliance within 14 calendar days of receiving the notification.

If a hearing is requested, the Senior Supervisor of Financial Aid NCAA Compliance will organize a hearing at the earliest availability of the appellate committee. The committee shall consist of the Senior Vice President for Student-Affairs, ?University Ombudsman, Faculty Athletics representative, Vice President of Student Financial Services, and Associate Director of Financial Aid-Student Services. If a committee member is unavailable to attend, a replacement will be selected by the Faculty Athletics representative.
